## FROM THE PRESIDENT

Hi everyone

Your Progress Association continues to work on several initiatives for the benefit of Empire Bay residents.

Our Food and Fun Fair planning is well advanced. We have many exciting stalls signed up including wines, craft beers, cider, food stalls, children's entertainment and local artists including our own Christie Chen. Please mark your diaries for 21 October 2023 commencing at 11.00 am and ending at 5.00pm. I am confident everyone will have a great day out. Please ensure you bring some gold coins on the day.

The restoration of the Empire Bay Cenotaph has commenced. We have received approval from the heritage department for the chosen stone, the stonemason has been appointed, the stone has been delivered and inscriptions are underway.

I had the opportunity to meet with Dr Gordon Reid, Member for Robertson in late August to discuss the various initiatives that your Progress Association is in discussion with council and where we are also seeking Dr Reid's support.

As reported in my last update, these include further upgrades to the foreshore play area, foreshore erosion prevention, foreshore enhancement projects, Shelly Beach Road upgrades and improving awareness of speeding limits on Greenfield Road. We also discussed the Empire Bay boatshed, your Progress Associations position in this respect and the recent publication of the boatshed Heritage report, a significant document of over 100 pages. This report is available online.

Your Progress Association's constitution clearly articulates "we will be an advocate and voice on matters that will enhance and protect our community, it's welfare (safety) and environment." The decision in respect of the boatshed and rectification of the foreshore clearly falls within the Progress Associations remit and constitution. Members of the Progress Association and indeed the wider Empire Bay community have a wide range of views - positive, neutral, and negative in respect of the boatshed requiring your Progress Association to remain neutral in this respect. For purposes of transparency, this position was communicated to the Boatshed Association in June.

In early September, Crown Lands were issued with a demolition order for the boatshed. Following this decision, the Progress Association will focus on ensuring our foreshore is restored, seek funding for foreshore regeneration and once again becomes fully accessible and safe.

Late 2022, early 2023 we commenced a project to upgrade our sheds at the Progress Hall. We deferred this in the hope that we could secure funding for this initiative. As we were unsuccessful in this respect, we are progressing the replacement of the sheds. It is hope that this will be complete prior to the end of 2023.

We continue to pursue several grant opportunities. As these progress we will communicate these to you where we have been successful. If there is anything in the community that you believe would benefit from grant funding, please drop me a note and I will review the opportunities as they are presented. Obviously, there is no guarantees in this respect, but I am happy to try on your behalf.

As noted in my last update, times are tough for some of our families and small businesses. We continue to see requests from food banks etc. Can I ask that where you can afford, please donate to these worthy organisations, and please visit and purchase from our own local small businesses — even if it is only a coffee. Every little helps.

As I comment in all my updates, it would be great to see many more of you at the Progress Association meetings. We are here to represent you at council, state, and federal level. It is critical that we hear from you to ensure our representation is fair, balanced and addresses the important issues to you.

Many thanks for your continued support.

### **Empire Bay/Bensville Rural Fire Brigade**

**GET READY WEEKEND:** The annual 'Get Ready Weekend' is fast approaching, this is an event dedicated to informing and educating home owners and residents on ways in which they can prepare in the event of a bushfire. This year, you can find us at the Empire Bay Village Fair on Saturday, 21 October 2023 at 11:00 AM onwards. This is a great chance to talk to volunteer members from our brigade and discuss issues or concerns relating to this fire season. We'll also be giving out FREE goodies (for adults and kids)!

**HAZARD REDUCTIONS:** Our brigade has been busy with assisting in Hazard Reductions in nearby areas in preparation for the Bush Fire Danger Period commencing on 1 October 2023. Please ensure that fire permits are lodged through the Central Coast Fire Control Centre: 1300 060 807. Stay indoors during HR operations, especially in regards to those with asthma or other conditions that affects the airways. Always call Triple Zero (000) for unattended fires or smoke.

**STATIONARY EMERGENCY LIGHTS:** The community is reminded that when emergency vehicles (including RFS vehicles) are stationary with emergency lights engaged, you must slow down to 40 km/h when the speed limit is posted as 80 km/h or under. This includes moving over if there is another lane to safely move into, as well as giving way to all pedestrians where emergency lights are engaged. This ensures all personnel are safe on our roads so we can safely perform our operations without interference.

**RECRUITING:** Empire Bay RFS is constantly looking for new members to join our family-orientated brigade. The RFS is not just a volunteer organisation; it's an adventure! From battling bushfires to working alongside other emergency services, your time with us will be filled with unforgettable moments and stories that won't be overlooked. Want more information? ## **PET CORNER**

## Dogs need to do stretches too

Especially during warmer days, it's great to be out and about with your dog. It's a great way to end the day with a stroll around the block. Going to the park or off-leash area and letting him stretch his legs and play with other dogs.

But ...can you over-exercise a dog? The answer is Yes. If your dog has been lazing around at home, make sure you get them up and moving a little to stretch their muscles before you take them for a walk/jog around the block. Many injuries occur when dogs have been lazing around home alone, jump in the car, leap out at the other end and run full speed along the beach only to pull up lame and sore fifteen minutes later.

Make sure he/she eases into speed gradually, get him/her up and moving, then walking, ease into a trot for a few minutes and then let him/her off lead. Remember that before you let him/her off-lead it's your responsibility that he/she's under effective control and will come back to you when you call. And don't forget your poo bag!
